Do you need to do an internship in a professional environment to obtain your diploma?

The AREXIS application is dedicated to internship agreements: Login with the **SEL Account credentials**



SHE ALLOWS YOU TO:

- Know the regulations;
- Enter and edit the agreement, tutor information and defense date;
- To enter and validate the theme, the problem and the plan in conjunction with your tutor.

Continuing education students, apprentices or on a professionalization contract must fill in the information on the internship platform. This procedure is mandatory to have access to information and to organize the defense.





HOW DO I GET MY INTERNSHIP AGREEMENT?

You will need to enter all the information concerning the practical arrangements of your internship (duration of the internship, schedules, tutors, etc.) in the tab : **Student Space > Contact Information**, then save.

Before drawing up your internship agreement, you must collect various data about your internship beforehand:

- the full address of the host organization,
- the telephone number of the switchboard or HR department,
 the name of the signatory of the agreement,
- · the web address of the host organization,
- · your internship theme and/or your missions,
- the first and last name of your guardian in the organisation as well as his or her position, telephone number and email address,
- the number of hours of presence per week,
- the amount of gratuity per month and benefits in kind (restaurant tickets, buses, etc.).

These information are mandatory to establish an internship agreement and will be directly inserted into your agreement. Don't forget the "internship theme" part, without which your agreement cannot be validated.

An email will be sent to you once your internship has been validated. You can
then edit it as a PDF. You will need to sign them and then send them to your
company for them to sign.

The signed agreement must then be returned to your IAE school manager for signature (directly or by email).

If the internship takes place abroad, you will have to provide a certificate of repatriation on which the dates of validity must appear.

<u>Please note</u>: If there are changes to be made to your agreement, you cannot do it yourself! You must contact the school.

A STUDENT CARD FOR YOU SIMPLIFIER LA VIE!

The multi-service student card is issued by the tuition department once your registration is complete.

Many services grouped together in a single card : • Identify yourself as a student of the University.

- Borrow documents from University Libraries.
- Access certain premises that require authentication (research laboratories, service rooms in university residences, etc.).

- This card also allows you to benefit from discounts in various shops (bowling, cinema, fast food, etc.).

THE CHOICE OF LANGUAGES

IAE offers several modern language courses.

- LV1 : English or French as a Foreign Language (for foreign students)
- LV2: German, Spanish (intermediate or advanced level), Chinese (beginner or advanced) and French as a Foreign Language (beginner, intermediate or advanced level).

Other languages may be offered to you, in partnership with the Maison des Langues, located on campus.

THE HOUSE OF LANGUAGES

The Maison des Langues, a joint service of the University of Poitiers whose mission is to promote the learning of modern languages, provides resources, training and online services for students and staff of the University of Poitiers. The MdL offers you the opportunity to take language certifications such as: IELTS, TOEFL, etc. These tests are mandatory as part of a semester of study in the United States, for example. The MdL offers methods and practice tests to prepare for these certifications.

TOEIC

The **TOEIC** is a business English test recognized in the business world. It is possible to obtain this certification on site at the IAE's premises. Several sessions are organized during the year.

THE PLACEMENT TEST

Depending on your field, the IAE organizes language placement tests to divide you into groups of levels at the beginning of the academic year.

English: Online placement test in September. Spanish: Online

placement test in September. German: Online placement test in

September.

FLE (French as a Foreign Language) and Chinese: There is no placement test for FLE and Chinese.

FLE (FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE)

Are you a foreign student and want to learn or deepen the French language?

The IAE sets up a 2-hour course per week. Indicate to the school office, at the time of your registration, that you wish to take FLE courses to join a group.

This course is open to all courses.

STUDENTS WITHOUT BORDERS, THE WORLD IS YOURS!

To live an experience rich in encounters, to develop your autonomy and your spirit of openness, to improve your language skills, to give an international dimension to your CV... while benefiting from financial aid. These are all good reasons to go abroad during your studies at IAE!



You have the possibility of studying abroad at the Bachelor's or Master's level 1 (depending on the course in which you are enrolled) for 1 or 2 semesters (departure in the 1st or 2nd semester) as part of an exchange program or another specific program set up by the IAE (Gap Year).

The International Relations Office organizes information meetings on study abroad programs at the beginning of the September academic year to leave for the 2nd semester and at the beginning of January to leave for the 1st semester of the following academic year. The dates and times will be communicated to you by e-mail at the appropriate time.



The Erasmus + programme allows you to spend 1 or 2 semesters in one of our partner universities in Germany, Austria, Belgium, Spain, Estonia, Finland, Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Switzerland or Sweden (the list of partnerships is subject to change).

SWITZERLAND

An exchange agreement with UPAEP in Puebla was signed in 2019, for students in the Master of Business Administration.



CANADA

In New Brunswick, at the Université de Moncton (Moncton and Shippagan campuses) or StJohn/Fredericton or in Quebec, as part of the BCI Student Exchange Program (CREPUQ), for 1 to 2 semesters.



SWEDEN

It is possible to do an exchange at our partner universities: Lund University, and Umea University (partners for more than 10 years).

GAP YEAR

The gap year consists of a student suspending his or her studies for a period of one to two semesters in an academic year in order to live a personal, professional or commitment experience in France or abroad (between L3 and M1 or between M1 or M2).

The gap year can be:

- professional experience related or not to the training
- the creation of a business/activity related or not to their training
- a civic service, a voluntary commitment to an association, in France or abroad
- an internship in a professional environment (if a semester requested is backed by 200 hours of training)
- any other personal project of the student (associative commitment, elective mandate, etc.).

ADMINISTRATIVE FORMALITIES BEFORE DEPARTURE

Once you are selected by the IAE and the partner university to carry out a mobility abroad, you must complete a number of administrative formalities such as:

REQUEST DE VISA

For departures outside Europe, you will have to apply for a visa at the Consulate of the country concerned, depending on the length of your stay.

Please note that the procedures, costs and deadlines for obtaining visas are specific to each country (check the websites of the embassies of the countries concerned). In some countries, you will need to obtain a study permit if the stay exceeds 6 months.

COVERED SOCIAL SECURITY FOR FOREIGN COUNTRIES

For departures to Europe, you are covered by the student social security scheme as long as you are enrolled at the University of Poitiers. Before your departure, you must apply for the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) from your Health Insurance Fund. For study stays outside Europe, you should know that you will have to register, in most cases, with the local Social Security. Find out beforehand on the website of the host university because the cost of social security can be much higher than in France

RESTORATION AT UNIVERSITY

For stays abroad in the 1st semester, don't forget to re-register at the IAE before your departure! You will have to present your student card from the University of Poitiers to the host university and the scholarship cannot be paid to you if you are not registered with us... You will also not be able to validate your academic year at the IAE

MUTUAL STUDENTS

Student social security is managed by the Approved Student Mutual Insurance Companies (national LMDE or regional SMECO). The student chooses his or her paying centre, i.e. one of these two mutual insurance companies, for the management of his or her student social security.

(SIUMPPS), located on campus (building C4)

When you enrol at the university, if you are no longer covered by your parents' social security and after paying your LMDE or SMECO student social security, you must declare general practitioner. а declaration is made by a form of "declaration of choice of treating physician" which will be provided to you by your doctor.

EXERCISE

The University Service of Physical and Sports Activities (SUAPS) offers all students and staff a wide range of physical and sports activities. Be careful, some slots are taken by storm from the start of the school year. So don't delay in registering.

The SUAPS is located on the main campus (building C6). All the sports facilities are located on the Campus or nearby. You will find the activities and slots adapted to your desires. The SUAPS also offers

FINANCIAL AID

WHO IS ENTITLED TO A GRANT BASED ON SOCIAL CRITERIA?

To be entitled to financial aid from the Ministry of Higher Education and Research or the Ministry of Culture and Communication, you must be under 28 years old on 1 September of the academic year and follow a course authorised to receive scholarship holders. The aid is allocated according to three criteria: the income of the tax household, the number of dependent children in the family and the distance from the place of study.

HOUSING ASSISTANCE (APL)

Students can, under certain conditions, benefit from financial aid from the CAF (Family Allowance Fund).

The application is made online on the website (under the heading "Online services" then

"Housing benefits").

The CROUS manages several university residences in Poitiers and has functional, furnished and furnished accommodation, ranging from single rooms to T3 (for shared accommodation for example). To apply for university accommodation, the application can be made online only at the address, under the heading "scholarships": www.crous-poitiers.fr.

Don't forget to apply for accommodation as soon as possible, the portal opens on 15 January!

YOUTH HOSTEL



ASSOCIATION FOOTPRINT






